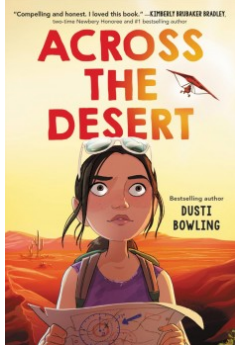


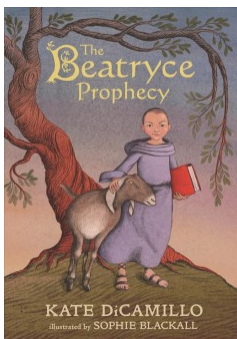

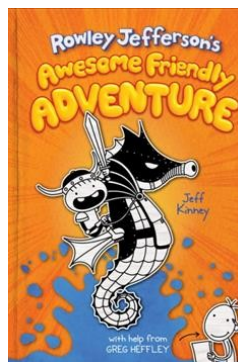
Across the Desert

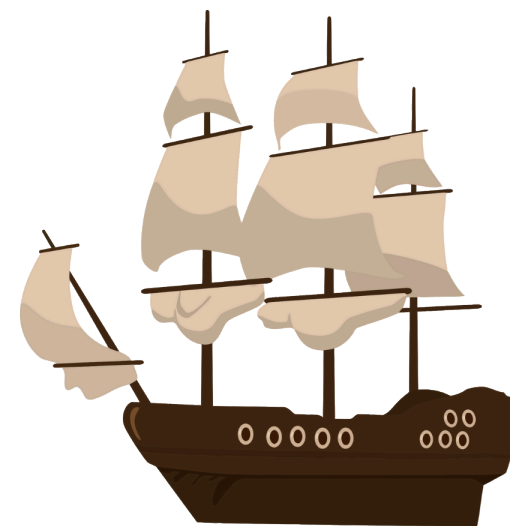


Wild River by Rodman Philbrick

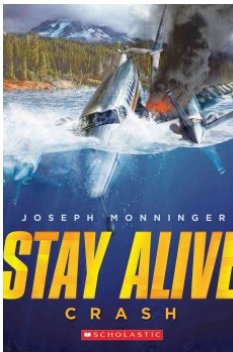

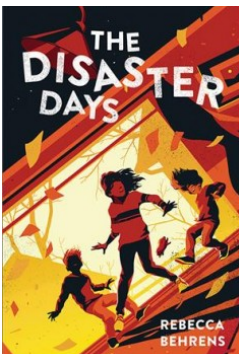
I Survived the California Wildfires, 2018 by Lauren Tarshis
