The Jumbies by Tracey Baptiste

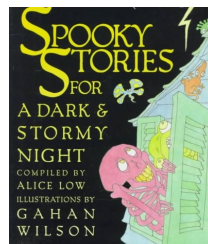
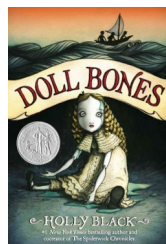
J Baptiste, T. | 234p.

Riverman by Aaron Starmer

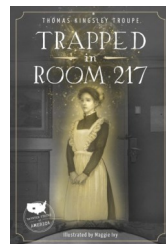
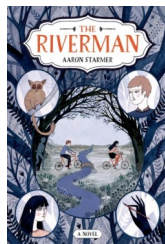
J Starmer, A. | 310p.
